






(people sit)

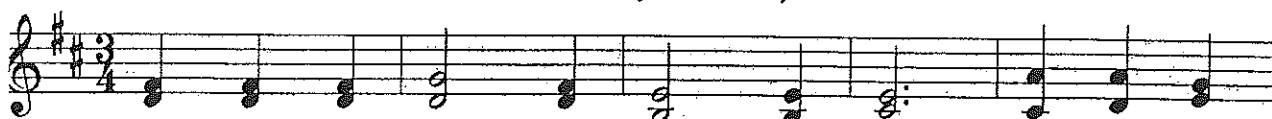
BREAD AND WINE ARE SHARED

All are welcome to receive Holy Communion. At the rail, you may stand or kneel. You may either receive the bread, eat it, and then drink from the cup or you may dip the bread into the cup. If you do not wish to receive from the cup, simply cross your hands over your chest as the Chalice Bearer approaches. If you do not wish to receive communion, you are welcome to still come to the rail, cross your arms, and receive a blessing.

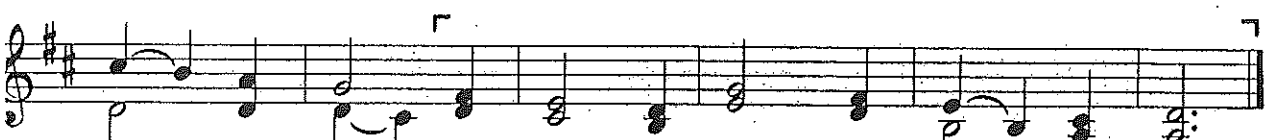




